Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable E. E. Hoffman prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Anton P. Chester I was convicted under the name of Anton P. Chester
