Application of G. N. Daniels

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of March A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3 District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable F. B. Stephens presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Rogers prosecuted the case.
