Application of Charles Samuelson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of April A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. E. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Frederick Samuelson I was convicted under the name of Charles Samuelson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Ralph Ross, and Kenith Lott

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Once before.
