Application of J. P. Johnson

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon, and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Abduction of Property

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of August A. D. 1920, at Ogden City, County of Weber and State of Utah, in the 1st District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. P. Johnson presiding

Third—I was sentenced to the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable J. P. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is J. P. Johnson I was convicted under the name of J. P. Johnson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
