Application of Arthur Welker

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April  
A. D. 1921, at Ordem County of Davis  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James Kimball presiding

Third—I was sentenced to one to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Atty. Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Arthur Welker  
I was convicted under the name of Arthur Welker

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same  
offense are as follows: William Neuteboom and  
Arthur Welker

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one
