Application of Eugene Farr

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Weber County under conviction and a sentence on a charge of having been a fugitive

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of March A. D. 1921, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the City Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. G. Wolcott presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to six months in the Weber County Jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Weber County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable David J. Moran prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Eugene Farr I was convicted under the name of Eugene Farr

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: James A. Manswood

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except before.
