First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Weber County, Jail
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of false personation

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th. day of July
A. D. 1920, at Ogden County of Weber

and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. E. Pratt presiding

Third—I was sentenced to serve five months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Weber County Jail, Ogden, Utah

Fourth—Honorable Stuart P. Dobbs prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Eddie Reddicks

I was convicted under the name of Eddie Reddicks

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same
offense are as follows: Edward Ross alias Edward Mix

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the offense
of Perjury to this charge I pled guilty before his Honor
Judge Henry Lund of the City Court of Salt Lake City, Utah.
