Application of Paul Lehmann

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 28 day of Feb. A. D. 1917, at Price County of Garbon and State of Utah, in Sixth Court, in and for the

County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. H. Christensen presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Knox Patterson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Paul Lehmann I was convicted under the name of Paul Limmer

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except twice for same offense
