Application of Lawrence Callahan

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a rehearing of application for termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of October A. D. 1917, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. L. Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to one year and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Lawrence Callahan I was convicted under the name of Lawrence Callahan

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
