Application of JIM JOUFLAS,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary under conviction and sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of March A. D. 1919, at Price, County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen, Judge presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth—Honorable Knox Patterson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jim Jouflas,

I was convicted under the name of Jim Jouflas,

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: No other persons.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except the above offense.
