Application of Neil Ramsland

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Dec  
A. D. 1920, at Cedar, Utah County of Keber  
and State of Utah, in 2<sup>d</sup> Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Agel presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence  
of from five to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
at Salt Lake City Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable District City Hobbs prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Neil Ramsland  
I was convicted under the name of Neil Ramsland.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: no one.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except present one.
