Application of LAWRENCE SULLIVAN

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Re-hearing and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Possession of stolen Goods

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of January A. D. 1920, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable H. M. Stephens presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the state prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Baldwin Robertson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Lawrence Sullivan I was convicted under the name of Lawrence Sullivan

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Paul Storey

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except this one Been on parole since Nov 5, 1920.
