

Salt Lake City, Utah, July 25th 1919

Application of George K. Kravaritis

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of grand larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the first day of March A. D. 1919, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding

Third—I was sentenced to indefinitely

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Knox Paterson prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George K. Kravaritis I was convicted under the name of George K. Kravaritis

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except no exception
