Application of Charles Lane

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in paroled May 18, 1920  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of grand larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A. D. 1920, at Richfield County of Sevier  
and State of Utah, in sixth district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hays presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Term not to exceed  
10 years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Samuel Page prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Charles Lane  
I was convicted under the name of Charles Lane

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same  
offense are as follows: Arthur Hines  
Charles Lane

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
