First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Sodomy

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of January A. D. 1913, at St. George County of Washington and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Joshua Greenwood presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Eight Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Edmund Carter prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Thomas La Crosse I was convicted under the name of Thomas La Crosse

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except One.
