Application of Albert Lister

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt Rape.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. A. D. 1922, at Paranguitol County of Sanfill and State of Utah, in 6<sup>th</sup> District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr. Carichson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to not to exceed 2 1/2 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. J. F. Bates prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Albert Lister I was convicted under the name of Albert Lister

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None except this one
