Application of A. V. Smith

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of Nov. A. D. 1917, at Tooele City County of Tooele and State of Utah, in 3d. District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. L. Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Wilson Mc Carthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Arthur L. Smith I was convicted under the name of A. V. Smith

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Bert Christy and Jack Dempsey

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
