Application of Wm E. Smalley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a rehearing
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of murder

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of March
A. D. 1916, at Utah County of Utah
and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to indefinite term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable O'Donnell prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William E. Smalley
I was convicted under the name of William E. Smalley

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same
offense are as follows: none

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except none
