Application of George P. Hughes.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of Feb.  
A. D. 1919, at Ogden County of Weber

and State of Utah, in the second district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Pratt presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Stuart P. Dobbs prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is George P. Hughes  
I was convicted under the name of George P. Hughes

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same  
offense are as follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except robbery
