and State of Utah, in C. P. Evans Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable at Benjamin Cannon presiding

Third—I was sentenced to life imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
at Salt Lake

Fourth—Honorable Malcolm McCarty prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Jhinney
I was convicted under the name of William Jhinney
