Application of W. B. McKnight

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole Rehearing and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 17 day of Oct A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake County of _____ and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Tobin presiding

Third—I was sentenced to six months to three years — indeterminate — and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Wilson M. Carty prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is William Byron McKnight I was convicted under the name of W. B. McKnight

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: _____
