Application of Willard Mercer

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Larceny

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of November A. D. 1919, at Tooele City, County of Tooele and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. H. Beames presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indefinite term in the State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable J. B. Gordon prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Willard Mercer I was convicted under the name of Willard Mercer.
