Application of Raymond Thorour

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with a deadly Weapon.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of January A. D. 1921, at Manti County of Sanpete and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable B. W. Dalton prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Raymond Thorour I was convicted under the name of Raymond Thorour

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Javier Burusco.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above.
