First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary 2nd degree

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of April A. D. 1921, at Provo, County of Utah and State of Utah, in 4th District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hansen presiding

Third—I was sentenced to a indeterminate sentence of from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable District Attorney Walmquest prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Edward Miller Jr. I was convicted under the name of Edward Miller Jr.
