Application of Jedediah Woodard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the County Jail
under conviction and sentence on a charge of involuntary manslaughter

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of April
A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable P. C. Evans presiding

Third—I was sentenced to one year in the County Jail

and thereafter was imprisoned in the County Jail on the 6th day of April
1918

Fourth—Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Jedediah Woodard
I was convicted under the name of Jedediah Woodard

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any other offense except

Eighth— I am years of age and during the time I have been
deprived of physicians. I have an opportunity to go to work
immediately and I am extremely anxious to get employment. The
confinement is undermining my health.
