Application of William Chapman

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Vagrancy

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of September A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ben Johnson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six Months and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Kelly prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Chapman I was convicted under the name of William Chapman

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Vagrancy
