Application of Elbert L. Brown

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a rehearing on termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of receiving earnings of prostitute

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of July
A. D. 1817, at Tooele County of Tooele
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Lewis Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Two Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Elbert L. Brown
I was convicted under the name of Elbert L. Brown

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as
follows: None

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None
