Application of Aron Hower

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State's Prison
under conviction and sentence on a charge of Third Degree Burglary

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of January
A. D. 1918, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge P. C. Evans presiding

Third—I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
in the Utah State's Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State's Prison on the
14th of January 1918
