Application of Bert Christy

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Lobbery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of Novm.
A. D. 1917, at Garfield County of Tooele
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Louis Brown presiding

Third—I was sentenced to indeterminate
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Nelson McLain prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Bert Christy
I was convicted under the name of Bert Christy

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same
offense are as follows: Jack Dempsey, A. T. Smith

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except none
