Application of Bert Christie,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole, and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the Fifth day of November, A. D. 1917, at Tooele County of Tooele and State of Utah, in Third District Court, Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Lewis Brown presiding.

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth—Honorable Wilson McCarthy prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Bert Christie, I was convicted under the name of Bert Christie.

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: A. E. Smith, and Jack Dempsey.

Seventh—I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
