Application of George McManess

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of September A. D. 1922, at Ogden, County of Weber, and State of Utah, in Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Geo. F. Barker, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evens, prosecuted the case.
