Application of Frank C. Anderson

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First—That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second—I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of October A. D. 1918, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Morgan presiding

Third—I was sentenced to Indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth—Honorable Mr. McDonald prosecuted the case.

Fifth—My true name in full is Frank C. Anderson I was convicted under the name of Frank C. Anderson

Sixth—The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
