First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of April A. D. 1937, at _____ County of San Juan and State of Utah, in 7th Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 10 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison until July 4, 1937 (Reprimed by E. E. Munnson, Acting Governor June 22, 1937)
