To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery, attempted Robbery and Assault with a deadly weapon

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September  
A. D. 1932, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake

and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five to Twenty years; Two and one-half to Twenty years, and  
nothing to five years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Arthur Joseph Hadka

I was convicted under the name of Arthur Hadka

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above three.
