Application of Benny Baker No. 6318

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of highway robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6 day of December A. D. 1934, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd. District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison on the 8th day of December 1934

Fourth-Honorable Clayton Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Old Edward Pedigo I was convicted under the name of Benny Baker

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Wm. Murphy

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
