First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of May A. D. 1936, at Richfield Utah County of Sevier and State of Utah, in 6th district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable _____ prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Earl C. Dunlap I was convicted under the name of Earl C. Dunlap
