First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the day of A. D., at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Roger I. McDonohue presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five Years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Gaynes

I was convicted under the name of John Gaynes

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As Record Shows
