Application of Eldon Eugene Taylor No. 6477

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION Or Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of November A. D. 1935, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Lester A. Wade presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Wade M. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elden Eugene Taylor I was convicted under the name of Eldon Eugene Taylor
