First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison,
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of November,
A. D. 1929, at Logan, Utah County of Cache
and State of Utah, in First Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable W. Horsley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John E. Flanigan.
I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
