Application of George Eccles No. 5217

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah state prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of June
A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in The 3rd district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McConkey presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve From one to Ten years in the
Utah state prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state pen

Fourth-Honorable Roy Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George Albert Eichelberger
I was convicted under the name of George Eccles
