under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of January
A. D. 1930, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in the 4th district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. A. Watkins presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 6 months to 3 years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison

Fourth-Honorable District Attorney Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Frank Cannon

I was convicted under the name of James Frank Cannon
