First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of January
A. D. 1930, at Provo County of Utah
and State of Utah, in 4th district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable V. A. Watkins presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 6 months to 3 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison

Fourth-Honorable Att. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Frank Cannon
I was convicted under the name of James Frank Cannon

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except burglary
in Oregon and grand larceny
in Idaho.
