Application of W. E. Salmon No. 5439.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August,  
A. D. 1930, at Monticello County of San Juan  
and State of Utah, in 7<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Delworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to not less than one and  
not more than ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Wm. Earl Salmon.

I was convicted under the name of Earl Salmon.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Rubie Watson.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
