First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of May
A. D. 1930, at Ogden County of Wasatch
and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Hermon Theodore Brown

I was convicted under the name of Jack Farrell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
