First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19/29 day of May June  
A. D. 1930 1932, at Ogden Brigham County of Weber Idaho  
and State of Utah, in First + Second district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Eugene E. Pratt  
Malvin C. Harvie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years on  
both charges  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Wesley Horvath prosecuted the case.
