First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of October
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Wasatch
and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five to Life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Fred Harold Meadows
I was convicted under the name of Fred H Meadows

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
