To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of October  
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison  
5 Years To Life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison  
17<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1928<sup>th</sup>

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Fred Harold Meadows  
I was convicted under the name of Fred W Meadows

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: John Adams

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
