Application of Charles E. Wilson No. 5836

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of May
A. D. 1932, at Richfield County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable H. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years in the
Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Henry E. Beale prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Edward Wilson

I was convicted under the name of Charles Edward Wilson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Once before for
Forgery. The charge I was sent here this
time was did two years ago at the same time
the other one was. We are to have a baby born to
us the 25th of July, please, please let
me out by then. I'll do right always; I promise you.
