I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of May
A. D. 1932, at Richfield County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in The Sixth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One To Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable H. E. Beale prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Edward Wilson
I was convicted under the name of Charles Edward Wilson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Once before on
this same thing. The six dollar check this time and the
fourdollar one were both written in Febuary of 1930 and
I had them all partly paid back at the time I was con-
victed on this oheck. WOnt You Terminate me? Iwant to
go to Colo. and work with my dad. Ill do right I promise you
