I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in ON PAROLE
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of May
A. D. 1932, at Richfield County of Sevier
and State of Utah, in Sixth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One To Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable H. E. Beale prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Charles Edward Wilson
I was convicted under the name of Charles Edward Wilson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Once on a similar
charge. Both of the checks were made out at the same time. It was
in Feb. 1930 and the brought one for \$4.50 against me then, I
was convicted on it. Then they brought the other one against
me. This one in 1932.
